



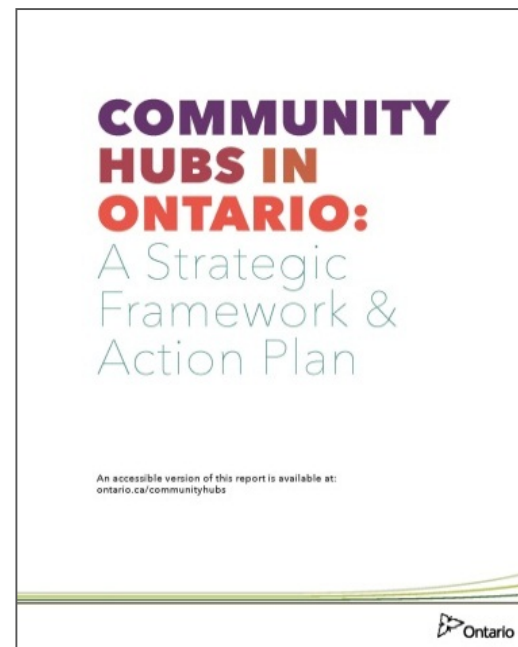

Our Journey

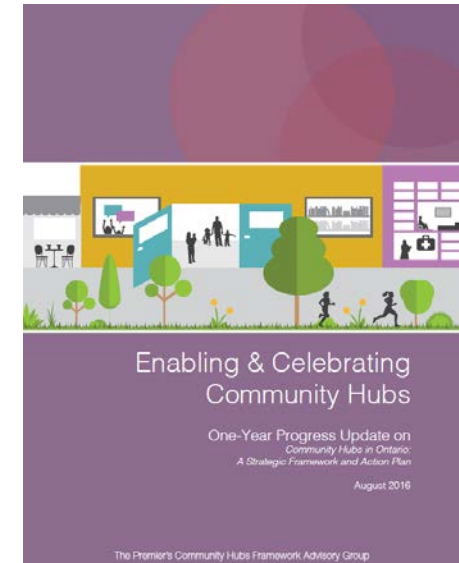
- Strategic Framework and Action Plan released in August 2015.
- Includes 27 recommendations to improve government policy and reduce barriers to community hubs organized in themes of client-focused service delivery, community infrastructure and public property and coordinated planning.
- In 2015, the government indicated its support for all of the recommendations and began work to implement with a broad cross-section of stakeholders.



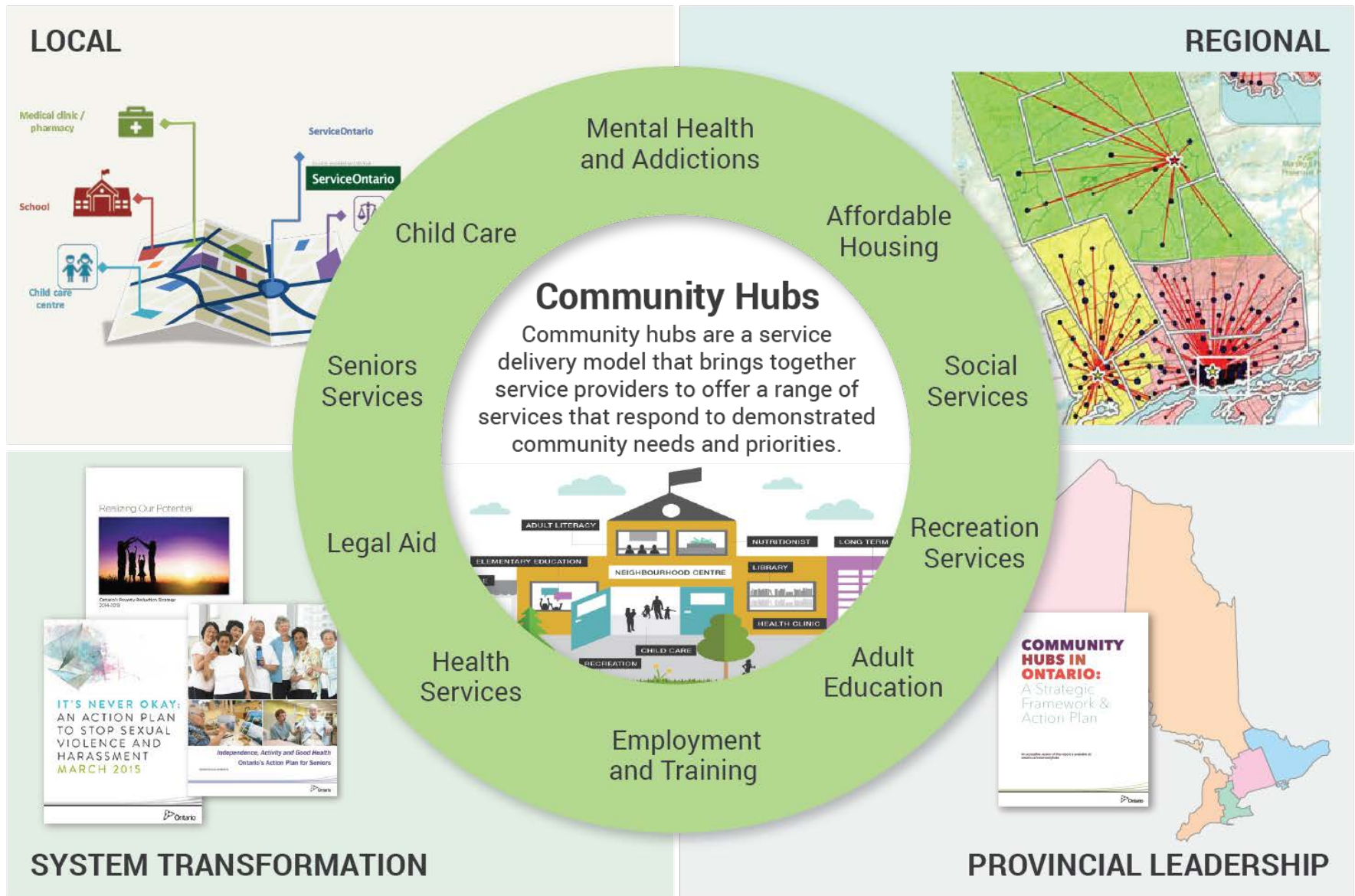
One-Year Progress

One-Year Progress Update released in August 2016.
Progress includes:

- Making it easier for potential partners to buy or lease surplus school property for community use
- Investing nearly \$90 million to create spaces in schools for community use
- Investing in a Resource Network that will have data and tools for community planning and help service providers share information
- The Treasury Board Secretariat hosted a Change Lab to spark creative ideas on how the government can change funding relationships with community hubs, making service innovation and integration easier

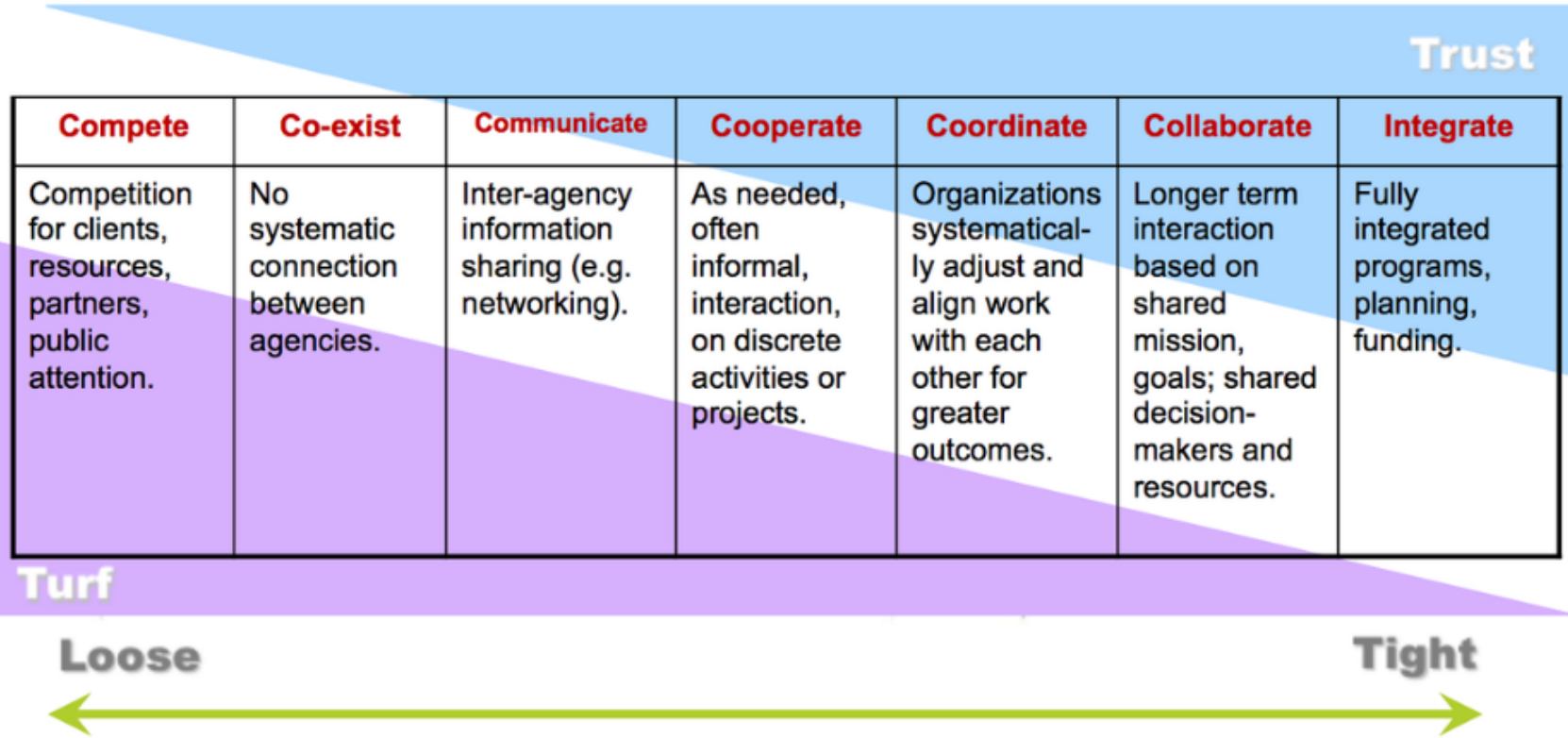
