

Local Media and Social Media Engagement 2025 ROMA Conference

The 2025 Rural Ontario Municipal Association (ROMA) Conference runs from Sunday, January 19 to Tuesday, January 21. This year's conference theme is *ROMA 2025: Rural Routes*. The two-day event will serve as a key moment for municipal and provincial officials to connect on the unique challenges faced by rural municipalities.

In addition to the conference program, municipal staff and officials will participate in hundreds of municipal delegation meetings with provincial ministries. Delegation meetings are an opportunity for municipal leaders to discuss key issues that are top-of-mind for municipal governments directly with provincial ministries.

This year's conference is an opportunity for participants to learn about ROMA's latest priorities, including advocating for housing-enabling infrastructure, improving access to primary health care, and developing practical solutions for homelessness.

Other sessions will cover topics ranging from fostering healthy local democracy and cyber security to community benefit agreements for energy and broadband projects and managing municipal waste. There will be a Ministers' Forum, as well as a question-and-answer period with an expert panel.

In addition to the <u>conference program</u>, municipal elected officials will take part in hundreds of delegation meetings with provincial ministries.
